## b) New Business

### c) Unfinished Business

- i) **Catch the Visions (Todd Noordyk)** Car show is the next event. It usual happens around Father's Day weekend. Details are yet to come because of the Boat & RV show. Soon there will be a discussion on sponsors and posters. MTBA has been donating \$500 each year towards events committee so we would like to make an official request as a sponsor.

### 3) Reports

- a) Marquette Township Business Association Facebook Page- Jessica made a post welcoming Bell Financial. Jessica wrote an article about all of the new businesses and shared it on facebook. Send Jessica anything that you may want posted on facebook.
- b) Website (Alex Baysore)- We had very impressive website views. MTBA is around 12,000 views each month. For February we had a total page views (people looking around at the different pages on the website and spending time on the website of 27,000. "Visits" is the actual number of people that came to the site which is about 13,000. There is no way to know if they are different people or repeat visitors. A lot of times it's spam which is usually removed from the report. Last year website stats: Total number of visits- 124,639 and the annual page views were 285,843. For a site our size our stats are quite good. The glitch that was on the website has been fixed. Everything is back to normal.
- c) **DDA Update (Todd Noordyk)** Alex asked Randy a couple of questions. During the roundabout construction there are only going to be 2 lanes open, one on each side. (Single Lane). Large trucks and semi trucks will be routed through Northwoods road.
- d) Marquette Township Board Treasurer (Ernie Johnson) The loan agreement between the waste water and the water department: money was loaned to the water department which took the interest rate from 4.75% to 1% which was about a \$14,000 savings for the water department. There were 2 loans- one will be paid off by the end of this year and the other will be paid in 2.5 years.

Marijuana- the township opted out and is waiting for the state to come out with some kind of legislation. Township is looking at generators for the township hall.

Tunnel design will be discussed. Planning commission has recommended that the tunnel be named "Pete's Pass". Pete O'dovero has made some financial donations for the project.

Storm water issues: The planning commission is looking at working with the county and the county wants the township to get involved: If residents who live on country roads fill in the ditches or culverts, they then want the township to put that dollar amount on the land owners taxes to help pay for the work they would have to do to reopen them. Road Maintenance: bidding is going out for crack fills and chip seals for many roads up to \$56,000. e) Marquette Township Planning & Zoning Administrator (Jason McCarthy) (Absent)
