- g) Marquette Township Planning & Zoning Administrator (Jason McCarthy/Ryan Diederichsen)
 - i) MDOT 2021 US 41 Resurfacing Project/Corridor Improvements- Preliminary design is done and there will be a meeting to review and approve
 - Township will have some revenue reductions- will plan to meet with businesses
 - Consolidate driveways
 - Received sustainability grant- Pedestrian connectivity, aesthetics, animal control, and storm water management
 - Infrastructure- Pictures were taken and rerendered various structures

- (a) Comments were made at the meeting, which was opened to the public and the renderings will be revised based on those comments
- (b) New renderings will be presented in June or July
- Hoping the DDA will be a part of all of this, but unsure because of COVD-19 struggles, and would require a levy to help facilitate this
- ii) 492 repaving project- Starting at the Target Walmart intersection, down 492 to the end of the Township
 - There will be detours, traffic will be rerouted
 - Detour map will be available on Facebook page
- iii) New businesses and development- Still very busy despite COVID-19
 - 3 or 4 new homes approved in March, also some sheds and decks
 - Discount Tire- Asked for a one-year extension on their site plan, may be 2021 till they break ground
 - Verizon and Dunkin Donut- Site plan to be reviewed
 - Fit Body Boot Camp- Approved in the mall
 - Fox Subaru- Rear access driveway in being improved, full façade treatment to the existing Ford dealership, also taken over the old Frei dealership
 - (a) Now have 3 dealerships
 - Dunham- Possibly coming back to the mall
 - Best Buy and McDonalds (in Walmart)- Both doing updates
 - Rose's Dug Out- Opened in the former Fat Boyz location, totally renovated inside and outside of building, local couple
 - Consolidation of two driveway, one going to NAPA and one going to Cenex, US41 and Wright Street- Making it easier and safer for people to enter these businesses
 - North Iron Church- Still working on moving into the former JC Penny's location and working out some issues
 - Climate and Health Adaptation workshop on May 7th was a visional workshop- Asking for as much feedback as possible by May 29th
