- A. Motion for Approval of December Agenda, November Meeting Minutes, and Consent Agenda- No quorum, no voting.
- B. Reports:

- a. Marquette Township Board Treasurer (Ernie Johnson):
 - i. The board is working on a loan for the Township Hall and Fire Hall.
 - 1. Will be voted on at Wednesday night meeting.
 - ii. Had a special meeting discussing activities that the Township can get involved in and the events committee.
 - 1. Township has decided the events committee is too much for them financially and personnel wise, so mediaBrew will be taking over the events committee.
 - 2. The car show and Christmas tree lighting will be fully run by mediaBrew.
 - 3. Community days will be a part of the Townships responsibility for at least another year to see if they can handle it.
 - 4. \$7,500 was the budget for the car show and Christmas tree lighting.
 - 5. Township will no longer be supporting mediaBrew financially.
 - iii. Someone is looking into developing the five acres behind Goodwill and Walmart.
 - 1. This is on the boards agenda to decide if they will enter into a purchase agreement and nothing else.
 - 2. Ernie is worried about the access road and wants to make sure it remains, but other than that he likes the proposal.
 - 3. 48 units proposed. A portion will be set aside for low/mid income. Will be a mix of different layouts.
 - 4. Renovare Development is the developer.
 - 5. This is Township owned so it will be headed by the Township.
 - 6. If Township approves, then plan will go to the planning commission for approval.
 - 7. \$50 thousand is the proposed amount and they did say they would pay it.
 - 8. That money would go to paying off the Township Hall.
 - 9. Township needs more low-income housing, so this would be great.

 - i. Events committee being taken over by meidaBrew!
- c. Marquette Township Planning & Zoning Administrator (Erik Powers):
 - i. Planning commission has a couple site plans to approve.
 - 1. TruNorth.
 - 2. The same developers as Panera have proposed another restaurant and retail right behind Panera.
 - a. If this is approved, they will move forward with all construction in 2024.
 - ii. Demolition permit submitted for Michigan sales building across from Taco Bell. Honor Credit will be building there.
 - iii. Michigan national resources acquisition trust fund grant option was denied. We have a higher income than other areas and not right next to walkways.
 - iv. Business licensing processing is being worked on.
- d. DDA Update (Frank Stabile):
 - i. TAP Grant is still being figured out for pedestrian walkways on Wright Street and Commerce Drive.
 - 1. Board decided that they wanted the pathway completely off the road, so it will cost a little more and has to be reengineered.
 - 2. Drainage issues and space issues.
 - ii. 100 thousand for the DDA is already spent.
 - iii. Trying to look forward to what the next project will be and then will need to determine what mils to charge.
 - iv. DDA was hoping to get the Township and City connected through pathways, but it has been very difficult.
